

Missouri Trade Mission to Israel



The State of Missouri will lead a trade mission to Israel March 22-24, 2016, providing a unique opportunity to meet directly with pre-qualified potential buyers of Missouri products.

In coordination with the U.S. Commercial Service, the DED International Trade and Investment Office will coordinate company meetings and networking activities for trade mission participants in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem with companies that have expressed an interest in the products or service you have to offer. In addition, we will provide market research and briefings, assistance with transportation, and help with other logistical issues. We will also be available for follow up after the trip to finalize sales.

Past Missouri trade missions have resulted in significant trade agreements, partnerships, and the sale of Missouri goods by participating companies. Israel offers prime opportunities for Show-Me State companies.

The U.S. is Israel's largest single trading partner. Since signing a Free Trade Agreement in 1985, US-Israel trade has grown eight-fold. Since 1995 nearly all trade tariffs between the U.S. and Israel have been eliminated.
